Mayor's Editorial



Dear residents of Rouzède,

Summer is gently coming to an end, inviting us to get back into the swing of things after summer months full of exchanges and news for our community.

Our landscapes have paid a heavy price this season due to particularly difficult weather conditions, marked by intense drought, which reminds us of the importance of collectively preserving and protecting our environment. In this regard, we will be in touch again next spring regarding the Legal Obligations for Brush Clearing (OLD), likely as part of an information and prevention campaign.

Despite the difficult and trying weather, life in our village remained vibrant. In particular, we shared our first Saint John's Day picnic at the fountain in L'Arbre. Although the weather forced us to postpone it, this gathering proved to be a wonderful moment of conviviality that we will definitely mark on your calendar for next year!

This summer also saw the launch of our new communication app, Iliwap, designed to simplify communication between the municipality and all of you. Of course, we want to assure you that we will continue to distribute important municipal information in paper format directly to your mailboxes. As for our village festival, organized by our dynamic Festival Committee, it successfully brought together residents and supporters of the village for two warm and festive days. Due to the weather conditions, the fireworks display unfortunately had to be cancelled, but a new date will be proposed before the end of the year.

Another major highlight of this summer was that every household received special glasses to safely observe the exceptional solar eclipse of August 12th. It should be noted that this equipment was provided entirely free of charge by the municipality.

The start of the new academic year marks the beginning of a new phase. It is from September onwards that the projects ordered at the beginning of the summer will begin, whether it be some roadworks or the conversion of our public lighting to LED technology (only on compatible lampposts).

The municipality will also be working on new projects for Rouzède, with the aim of involving all interested residents. You are invited to attend our public meeting on this topic on Saturday, November 14th.

Until we meet again at our next events, the next major event being the seniors' meal on November 11, we wish you all an excellent start to the new school year.

■ CITY COUNCIL

Risk prevention: the municipality mobilized

Faced with an exceptional situation marked by three successive heat waves, a lack of rainfall, and a high risk of fire, the municipality of Rouzède implemented several prevention and community support measures. Throughout the heat wave, the municipal library, equipped with air conditioning, was open to residents every day from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. In addition, designated elected officials visited individuals who were alone, isolated, or vulnerable to check on them and ensure their well-being.

During its meeting on July 9, the Municipal Council also adopted the Municipal Emergency Plan (PCS). This document outlines the municipality's organization in the event of an emergency or crisis. It lists, in particular, vulnerable individuals, shelters, elected officials and designated contacts for each geographic area, as well as the resources to be mobilized to ensure public safety. The Municipal Emergency Plan, along with all the minutes of the Municipal Council meetings, can be consulted on the Illiwap application and on the municipality's website.

ODL: The municipality of Rouzède is located in an OLD zone: Legal obligations for brush clearing which implies special measures and compliance with certain brush clearing and maintenance obligations.

A public information and exchange meeting will be organized next March.

■ 2027 CENSUS

The population census will take place in Rouzède from January 21 to February 20, 2027. This operation, organized by INSEE in partnership with the municipality, allows us to determine the number of inhabitants and better adapt services and facilities to the needs of the population. A call for applications is open to recruit the census taker who will conduct the census in our town. Are you available and enjoy interacting with residents? ■ LOCAL URBAN DEVELOPMENT PLAN: PLUI

A public inquiry organized by the inter-municipal council will take place from September 28th to October 30th at noon, regarding the implementation of the Local Urban Development Plan (PLUI). This inter-municipal document sets out the conditions for land development and use. It will be posted in our town starting September 3rd.

■ SENATORIAL ELECTIONS: A USER'S GUIDE

The senatorial elections take place every three years. They are scheduled for September 27, 2026.

On this occasion, half of the seats are renewed. The term of office for a senator is six years.

Senators are not directly elected by citizens but by an electoral college of "grand electors" (indirect suffrage). The electoral college is composed of the deputies and senators of the department, regional councillors, departmental councillors, territorial councillors and delegates of the municipal councillors.



The delegates of the municipal councillors represent 95% of the approximately 162,000 electors of the senators.

■ NOVEMBER 11TH COMMEMORATION AT 11AM

Every November 11th, France gathers to commemorate the Armistice of 1918, marking the end of the First World War, and to pay tribute to the soldiers who fell for the Nation.

The municipality invites all residents, associations, flag bearers, veterans to join in this republican tribute at the war memorial, for this remembrance ceremony on Wednesday, November 11, 2026 at 11 a.m.

ELDERLY MEAL

Following the ceremony, the traditional Senior Citizens' Meal will be served in the village hall. It is offered to residents of Rouzédois aged over 60.

An invitation and a reply slip will soon be delivered to mailboxes. To confirm your attendance, please return this slip to the town hall before November 3rd. Those not eligible for free admission, as well as accompanying persons (family, friends, or relatives who do not meet the eligibility requirements), are also welcome, subject to a fee. We look forward to seeing you there.

■ PUBLIC INQUIRY ON MOBILITY

An inquiry organised by the community of municipalities will take place during September on the issue of passenger transport and mobility in our territory.

■ THE LIBRARY: A CULTURAL SPACE OPEN TO ALL



Housed in the nostalgic setting of the old school classroom, the municipal library is open year-round, from September to the end of July. All residents of the town are welcome!

To keep this space for sharing alive, a team of four dedicated volunteers takes turns welcoming you on Mondays and Saturdays, according to a schedule set each quarter. Committed to fostering a love of reading, they carefully select numerous new titles each year to enrich the collection. Recent acquisitions include **Une unique lueur** by Fred Vargas and **J'emporterai le feu** by Leïla Slimane. The municipality has adopted the ILLIWAP application to allow the residents of Rouzède to follow village news and obtain priority information.

This application will be the primary means of communication for sharing important and urgent information about our community. Therefore, we encourage you to download it without delay. It's a reliable way to access information on your mobile phone, and it's free and ad-free. The annual cost to the municipality is €678 (including the application, website and its hosting, and associated services). In comparison, the cost of our previous system was €889.56.

NOTRE-DAME CHURCH IN THE SPOTLIGHT

A beautiful day dedicated to heritage and conviviality.



ROUZÈDE

Le village va mettre en lumière son église

La commune invite ce dimanche les habitants et visiteurs à une soirée mêlant patrimoine et musique autour de l'église Notre-Dame, récemment restaurée.

David Bourbon, maire de Rouzède, et son conseil municipal donnent rendez-vous aux habitants et aux amoureux du patrimoine dimanche 7 juin à partir de 17 h autour de l'église Notre-Dame. Une soirée gratuite placée sous le signe de l'histoire, de la musique et du partage, destinée à mettre en valeur ce monument emblématique du village.

Un répertoire mêlant œuvres classiques et compositions personnelles.

Située au cœur du bourg, l'église Notre-Dame est un édifice romain des XI^e et XII^e siècles qui fait l'objet depuis plusieurs années d'importants travaux de restauration. La municipalité s'est engagée dans un programme visant à préserver ce témoin majeur de l'histoire communale et à lui redonner tout son éclat.

Construite dans un style roman

massif à double nef, l'église a connu plusieurs transformations au fil du temps. L'une des plus marquantes remonte au XV^e siècle avec l'ajout d'un bas-côté au sud, venant modifier sa silhouette d'origine.

Plusieurs éléments remarquables
L'édifice abrite plusieurs éléments remarquables. Parmi eux figurent des fonts baptismaux du XII^e siècle classés au titre des monuments historiques, un retable monumental en bois sculpté et peint du XVII^e siècle, restauré en 1993, ainsi qu'une représentation de Saint-Roch datant du XV^e siècle. Haut de sept mètres, le retable attire particulièrement le regard avec ses colonnes torsadées, ses riches décors végétaux et ses scènes illustrant la vie du Christ.

Depuis 2021, sous l'impulsion de la précédente municipalité conduite par Anne Bernard, plusieurs chantiers ont été réalisés : refectoire de maçonnerie, réparation de la cloche, pose de dispositifs de protection contre les in-

seaux, travaux de zingaperte, rénovation intérieure au badigeon de chaux et mise aux normes électriques. Ces interventions représentent un investissement de plusieurs dizaines de milliers d'euros. La commune souligne également la contribution des entreprises et artisans locaux qui ont participé à ces restaurations.

Résumé

Au-delà de son intérêt architectural, l'église conserve aussi une part de la mémoire du village. Certains habitants évoquent encore avec nostalgie l'ancienne rivalité entre le curé et l'instituteur autour du fameux « puits à deux manivelles », chacun refusant autrefois de partager la même pompe.

Le programme du 7 juin débute à 17 h par une messe célébrée par le père Sébastien. À 18 h, Chantal Paulat, passionnée d'histoire locale, conduira une déambulation commentée permettant de découvrir les richesses et les anecdotes liées à l'édifice.

La soirée se poursuivra avec un

concert de la soprano et pianiste Lyda Van Tol, accompagnée de la chorale « Lyda's Ladies ». Installée dans la région depuis plusieurs années, la musicienne d'origine néerlandaise partagera avec le public un répertoire mêlant œuvres classiques et compositions personnelles. Entourée de

l'acoustique chaleureuse de l'église pour offrir un moment musical intimiste. La manifestation s'achèvera autour du verre de l'amitié servi à la salle des fêtes, une façon pour la commune de célébrer son patrimoine, son histoire et le dynamisme de sa vie locale.

PINK OCTOBER: THE TOWN OF ROUZÈDE IS MOBILIZING

Created in 1985, Pink October is an annual campaign to raise awareness about breast cancer screening and support research. Symbolized by the pink ribbon, it highlights the importance of prevention in the face of this disease, which accounts for nearly a third of new cancers diagnosed in women.

Screening is a simple step that can save lives. Fully covered by insurance, it is recommended every two years for women aged 50 to 74.

The municipality of Rouzède is joining this national campaign by displaying the pink ribbon, a symbol of solidarity, hope and mobilization.



Heritage & Living Environment

MUNICIPAL WORKS: MAINTENANCE AND IMPROVEMENT OF ROADS

The municipality is continuing its program of maintenance and improvement of roads and drainage networks in several areas of Rouzède. These interventions aim to preserve the quality of the roads, facilitate traffic flow and enhance user safety.

In La Séguinie, coming from Bellefond, the culvert crossing the road will be replaced over a length of approximately 10 meters to replace the damaged section. A drainage channel will also be installed to improve the collection and evacuation of rainwater.

At La Rousserie, an old water reservoir will be filled in to secure and preserve the surrounding area.

At Le Four, the runoff from a culvert will be redirected under the path towards the neighboring meadow to preserve the quality of the path leading to La Meynardie. Approximately 25 meters of culvert will be installed, and a protective barrier will be built at the outlet to limit erosion caused by runoff.

In Beausoleil, the works will improve water drainage by extending a trench and a ditch, creating a flow directed towards the woods. The path has also been resurfaced.

On the Grelière road, before the intersection towards Le Bourny, approximately 70 meters of culverts will be installed. The embankment will be leveled where visibility is reduced, and the shoulders will be resurfaced with limestone to improve traffic safety.

At La Grelière, the entrance to the ditch located at the bottom of the barn will undergo specific improvements, including the installation of a plate to secure the passage. The installation of a culvert over 30 meters long will also improve drainage and protect neighboring houses.

Finally, a road repair campaign is planned. It will require approximately three tons of materials and several days of work.

All of these works are part of the municipality's commitment to ensuring regular and sustainable maintenance of its infrastructure, while improving the safety and quality of life for its residents.

The total budget for these works amounts to €23,840.00 including VAT

Rouzède switches to LEDs

In order to reduce its electricity consumption and modernize its public lighting, the municipality of Rouzède has undertaken the replacement of 65 incandescent bulbs with LEDs. The work began on August 20th.

With a total cost of €12,400, this operation represents less than €5,000 to be borne by the municipality, the balance being financed by the Green Fund and the Departmental Electricity-Gas Syndicate.

More economical and durable, this new equipment should allow the municipality to save between €500 and €1,000 per year, while continuing its efforts towards energy transition and more modern public lighting.
